GENERAL INFORMATION

Bucharest is the capital city and industrial and commercial centre of Romania, located in the southeast of the country, on the Dâmbovită river. The city proper has a population of 2,082,000 inhabitants, together with the metropolitan area comprising approximately 2.3 million people.

Bucharest is the first political and administrative centre of the country, being the resident place of the Presidency, the Parliament, the Government, the headquarters of many political parties, cultural and educational institutions, financial and commercial institutions and banks.

Sights and landmarks

The Palace of the Parliament

It was built by the communist dictator Nicolae Ceausescu (then known as the Palace of the People) and it is the third biggest building in the world after the Pentagon and the Merchandise Mart. The huge building hosts the Museum of Contemporary Art.

The Cismigiu Gardens

The Gardens were built as a public garden in the center of Bucharest in 1847 after the plans of the German architect Carl F.W. Meyer.

National Museum of Art

Located in the former royal palace, the museum features notable collections of medieval and modern Romanian art, as well as the international collection assembled by the Romanian royal family. The modern Romanian collection features sculptures by Constantin Brâncuși and Dimitrie Paciurea.

Patriarchal Cathedral

The construction of the impressive size cathedral began sometime between 1654-1658 in the period of Constantin Serban and was finished 7 years later. It reproduces the plan of Curtea de Arges Monastery.

Romanian Athenaeum

Founded in 1888, with Greek temple aspect, having columns in Ionic style at entrance; gorgeous interior with round frescoes showing moments from the Romanian history.

The championship will take place in Bucharest, capital of Romania, during the period:

The competition will take place at the Polyvalent Sport Hall (Address: Blvd. Tineretului no. 1, District (Sector) No. 4, Bucharest)

Male and Seniors 18 Yrs and above

Male and Female Cadets 16-17 Yrs

Boys and Girls 10-15 Yrs

NUMBER OF COMPETITORS:

Individual event, maximum two competitors per country in each category.

Team event, one team per country in each category.

Children's event no limit of competitors from each country.

20 euro per category in individual events

60 euro per category in team Kata

60 euro for senior female team Kumite

100 euro senior men team Kumite

JUDGES AND REFEREE:

All qualified Judges and Referees are welcome. Please provide names and license at the Registration on Friday 31st of October 2008 between 14:00 – 21:00 at the

Polyvalent Sport Hall

RULES:

The Federation of European Wado Kai Championships will be carried out according to the rules set by World Karate Federation (WKF). There is repechage in cadet and senior categories but not in the children's categories. There are two third prizes. "Designated Kata" for the first round of the European Wado Kai Championships has been decided to be "Seishan".

For Kata Competition, choose between the ten Wadokai Katas

1. Kushanku 2. Naihanchi 3. Seishan 4. Chinto 5. Bassai 6. Wanshu 7. Niseishi 8. Jitte 9. Jion 10. Rohai

Children can also choose between the five Pinan Katas.

In the Finals of Team Kata Competition there will be NO demonstration of the meaning of the Kata (Bunkai).

NB! CHILDREN RULES:

Duration of the Kumite bout is 1 ½ minutes. The competition area is 6x6 m. Mitts are compulsory and allowed to be white. Shin pads are allowed, but not foot protection.

When a bout ends with a tie (Hikiwake) there is no Encho-sen the decision will be

made by vote (Hantei). All contact to the head, face and neck is forbidden. If there is just a slightly "skin touch" a warning or penalty should be given according to article no 9 WKF rules. A score is awarded when a technique is performed according to the six criteria and with a distance for chudan between "skin touch" and 10 cm and for jodan between NO skin touch and 10 cm. Mubobi is not applied. If a Mubobi situation appears, the referee should stop the match and explain for the contestant that one have to take adequate measures for self chance.

IMPORTANT NOTES – PROTECTION:

WKF kumite Rules Article 2 point 8 state that the following protective equipment are compulsory for all competitors:

8.1. WKF approved mitts, one contestant wearing red and the other wearing blue.

8.2. Gum shield

8.3. The female chest protector approved by the WKF

8.4. The shin pads approved by the WKF, one contestant wearing red and the other wearing blue.

8.5. The foot protection approved by the WKF, one contestant wearing red and the other wearing blue.

Groin Guards are not mandatory, but if worn, they must be of approved WKF type.

INSURANCE:

All participants and members of delegations must effect their own medical insurance and personal trip insurance.

The Romanian Modern Karate Federation- Wado Kai Departments and the Federation of European Wado Kai are taking no liability for those concepts.

DOPING CONTROL:

The participant commit themselves to valid doping rules.

Doping control can take place.

All payments must be in Euro in cash at the registration Friday 31st of October 2008 between 14:00 – 21:00 at the *Polyvalent Sport Hall*.
